A161, Haxey to Graiselound Highway Improvements – Phase 2

North Lincolnshire Council intend to carry out major roadworks along the A161, Haxey Lane between Haxey and Graiselound, for approximately 550m starting at the junction with Low Street going southwards. This work is programmed to commence on the 20 July 2009 lasting for approximately three months. The works will involve installing new highway drainage including gullies and pipework. Additionally we will be replacing and re-profiling the existing road surface with high strength materials.

During the three-month period we will be operating a traffic management system using temporary traffic lights to carry out the works safely. To outfall the new drainage system and install a diversion culvert we will have to construct three road crossings involving deep excavated trenches, this will be carried out whilst the road is closed over three weekends. The dates are as follows.

- 8th & 9th August 2009;
- 5th & 6th September 2009; and
- 3rd & 4th October 2009.

Additionally when the road re-surfacing is carried out this will also be done using a road closure; this is programmed for the week commencing 19th October 2009 and will last for 5 days. Advance signs will give notice of the closure dates and the diversion route will be properly signed. The diversion route for HGV's southbound will be the A161, A18, A614, B1396 and C206 Akeferry Road, northbound will be the reverse. Non HGV's will be signed through Haxey and Westwoodside. At all times during these closure periods access will be available for residents, emergency services and timetabled bus services.

Whilst we will endeavour to work in a manner to keep delays and congestion to a minimum it will be inevitable that at times unforeseen problems will occur and I apologise for this in advance. If you require any further information please do not hesitate in contacting me.

Licensing Policy - Review
Street Trading and Collections Policy

The Street Trading and Collections Policy is now due for review. As well as carrying out a Consultation with relevant parties, we are setting up a Working Group to finalise the Policy.
