

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF AN ORDER

Highways Act 1980 and Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 North Lincolnshire Council

Public Footpath 93 Haxey Order 2009(1)

On 14 January 2010, North Lincolnshire Council confirmed the above order made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981.

The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert the 560-metre-long footpath commencing at grid reference SE78070074 and leading north easterly to grid reference SE78350122, to a 580-metre-long section of footpath running northwards to grid reference SE78160132, as shown on the order map.

A copy of the order as confirmed and the order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at Church Square House, Church Square, Scunthorpe, from 9.30 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. on weekdays, other than bank holidays. Alternatively, the order may be viewed on the web site at www.northlincs.gov.uk/publicrightsofway. Copies of the order and map may be bought at Church Square House at the price of £1.50.

The order comes into force 42 days from the date of confirmation, but if any person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 8 February 2010, make an application to the High Court.
