

# VOLUNTEERS REQUIRED

Following the severe weather event that we experienced in November / December 2010, NLC has developed a Winter Service Policy, after a wide ranging consultation exercise, which it is anticipated will provide improvements to the service to overcome issues which arose last year.

NLC has increased its salt stock and they have some 5,300 tonnes available. A revised road salting regime is to be introduced covering precautionary and secondary routes.

The Parish Council has already been provided with 2 tonnes of additional salt and extra salt bins. A number of contractors / farmers in the parish have registered to carry out snow clearing work and NLC has allocated a fixed budget for the Parish Council to pay for this work to be done locally.

The Parish Council has appointed a Snow Warden, to advise on work to be carried out to clear snow, who will report to the Lead Snow Warden, Ward Cllr Ron Allcock who will liaise with NLC Winter Control Team to authorise and activate contractors to carry out snow clearance in our parish.

The Parish Council are looking for volunteers to assist in snow clearing if and when necessary. A list of priority areas will be created and these are the areas that will need clearing. If you are interested please contact the Clerk with your name and contact details and you will be placed on the list of volunteers and contacted by the Snow Warden with further details.
