## **Temporary closures of the Household Recycling Centres for refurbishment**

Signage will be put up on each site approximately three weeks prior to closing to alert site users. The website will also show updated information and provide alternative provision.

For residents who have van permit, they may use an alternative site during the period of closure of their allocated permit site during the closure period **only**.

When Scunthorpe is closed for its refurbishment we will be opening Kirton, Broughton and Winterton 7 days a week from 8am to 6pm during that period only. Tyres and plasterboard will only be accepted at Winterton HRC during this period, not at the other two sites. Also, asbestos will be accepted at Winterton for this period between the hours of 10am to 4pm.
