HAXEY PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes from the meeting held on Tuesday 31st October, 2017 at 7pm at The Foreman Carter Centre, Westwoodside Playing Field, Westwoodside.

Present: Cllrs Allcock, Booth, Carlile, Condliff, Cooke, Foreman, Lange, Knowles, Orton,

Smedley & Whitehead.

Also Present: Deb Hotson – Parish Clerk & 7 residents.

Chairman: Cllr Knowles presided.

Public Participation

Cllr Knowles stated that the meeting would include the co-option of a new Parish Councillor which entailed certain mandated procedures to be implemented. There were 2 candidates and after taking advice from ERNLLCA both candidates should be present to allow each to address the Council to ensure that one does not have an advantage over the other. He noted that one Candidate was present and that the other Candidate had advised the Clerk that he could not attend; therefore, the Council would not be addressed. Cllr Foreman asked for confirmation that both Candidates had been advised of the opportunity to be present and this was confirmed.

Mrs Kelsey and Mrs Wright asked if they could place a display of painted stones, collected by parish children, of a poppy on Dr Dysons Garden for Remembrance Day. This was very much welcomed by members and both residents were asked to provide photographs which could be included in the Arrow. The stones will stay in place for November and will then be removed. It was suggested this was also done for the following year too. Both residents were invited to the service on 10/11. Mrs Wright stated that her husband was ex-military and he would undertake a presentation of the poppy when completed. Mrs Pantry stated that NLC have a work ticket in place to carry out repairs on Turbary Road. 2 residents left the meeting.

Cllr Knowles opened the meeting.

- 1710/01 Apologies for absence received from Cllrs Fiddler, Harris & Lindley.

 Cllr Lange stated that Cllr Harris had been admitted to hospital in preparation for an operation scheduled for tomorrow. The Council wished him well.
- 1710/02 The minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on 26th September, 2017 with the subsequent agreed matters of accuracy were approved as a true and correct record. **Proposed: Cllr Orton, seconded:** Cllr Lange. 10 for with 1 abstention.
- 1710/03 To record declarations of interest by any member of the Council in respect of the agenda items listed below. Members declaring interests should identify the agenda item and type of interest being declared.

Cllr Allcock stated that he would not be participating in discussion on planning applications as he may be called to substitute on Planning Committee meetings. When Cllr Allcock is not a substitute at a meeting, he will be able to participate in cases and talk at meetings on behalf of the Parish Council and/or residents.

Cllr Smedley declared a personal interest in agenda item 1710/06 2017/1506.

Cllr Lange declared a personal interest in agenda item 1710/05.

Cllr Carlile declared a personal interest in agenda item 1710/06 2017/1640 and 1710/09.

Cllr Booth declared a personal interest in agenda item 1710/06 2017/1469.

Cllr Knowles declared a personal interest in agenda item 1710/20 and 1710/24.

1710/04 To note dispensations given to any member of the Council in respect of the agenda items listed.

Dispensations were noted for all Cllrs present for agenda item 1710/16 with regard to the Parish Council being Sole Trustees of the Westwoodside Playing Field Association.

1710/05 To be notified of the application(s) received for the Parish Council Vacancy determining actions required.

The two candidate's co-option forms were circulated prior to the meeting and both applicants were invited to attend the meeting. The Chairman confirmed that ALL Councillors had seen the co-option forms and set out the procedure for co-option: Candidates would be named in alphabetical order and votes for each would be counted.

Resolved – votes for Mr Jerry Henwood – 9, votes for Mark Parkin – 1. 1 abstention from voting.

Resolved – to record the vote. Proposed: Cllr Allcock, seconded: Cllr Orton. 7 for with 4 against.

Voted for Mr Henwood - Cllrs Allcock, Carlile, Condliff, Cooke, Foreman, Knowles, Orton, Smedley & Whitehead.

Voted for Mr Parkin – Cllr Booth.

Abstention – Cllr Lange.

Mr Henwood who was present at the meeting was congratulated and the Clerk will send out the relevant information and he will be invited to join the next meeting.

1710/06 **Planning**

a. To receive any decisions and the following applications received from NLC.

Cllr Foreman asked why the Clerk had submitted comments with regard to PA/2017/1539. Under item 46 of the Annual Meeting of the Parish Council under delegated powers the Clerk will submit comments if an extension cannot be obtained between meetings. Cllr Foreman stated he was not happy with this and wanted this issue back on the agenda for discussion again. Post meeting note, the Chairman would provide a written brief to Councillors present on the submission of comments for PA/2017/1539 and the Appeal submission for Hill Brow on 9th Oct 2017.

The following decisions were received from NLC.

2016/831 – application for determination of the requirement for prior approval for a proposed change of use of agricultural building to dwelling house (C2) at barn adjacent to Mansfield House, Cove Road, Westwoodside requires a full planning application to be submitted for determination.

2016/836 – appeal has been dismissed for the change of use from dwelling house (C3) to Children's Home (C2) at The Old Barn, Owston Ferry Road, Low Burnham.

2017/1 – appeal has been made against the decision to refuse planning permission for a change of use of domestic garage to vehicle repair garage at Hill Brow, A161 between Epworth and Haxey, Low Burnham. The Clerk under delegated powers resubmitted the Councils objections and specific comments on the basis of the appeal with regard to Parish Council actions.

2017/298 – outline planning permission granted to erect a detached dwelling with appearance, landscaping, layout and scale reserved for subsequent approval at Redlands, 108 Akeferry Road, Westwoodside.

2017/962 – full planning permission granted to erect a replacement dwelling (resubmission of 2017/89) at 2 Nethergate, Westwoodside.

2017/1007 – refusal of planning permission to retain the change of use from a dwelling house (C3) to a residential care home (C2) at 31 Low Street, Haxey.

2017/1123 – full planning permission granted for a change of use from B1 Light Industrial to D2 Assembly and Leisure for use as a community youth hub at former factory adjacent to 33 High Street, Haxey.

2017/1299 – full planning permission granted to erect a new dormer bungalow at land adjacent to 13 Craycroft Road, Westwoodside.

2017/1330 – refusal of planning permission to erect a detached two storey dwelling with integral garage at land between 47-51 Akeferry Road, Westwoodside.

2017/1390 – determination of the requirement for prior approval of a household extension at 9 Goodburn Row, Westwoodside is not required.

2017/1539 – application for determination of the requirement for prior approval for a proposed change of use of an office building use (B1(a)) to a dwelling house (C3) at grading shed, Ferry Road, Graizelound.

The Clerk requested an extension for this application and NLC response was that this is not a planning application and is being applied for under the prior approval route. Therefore, there is no requirement to formally consult the parish council on this application as it is seeking the principle of development under a prior notification to the local planning authority. Under this procedure we can only consider issues relating to highways, contaminated land and flood risk; therefore, the relevant consultees are contacted for their views. It is at the discretion of the local planning authority as to who is consulted on these types of applications.

The Clerk submitted the following comments under delegated powers.

This application is the subject of two previous applications - PA/2016/2026 and PA/2017/483 it seeks, under the GDPOs, to develop land in the open countryside without proper planning. PA/2016/2026 sought to convert an agricultural building to 3 dwelling houses. This was refused on the 20th February 2017 as it exceeded 450 square metres as allowed under part Q of the GDPOs. PA/2017/483 was a prior approval and sought to partially demolish the same agricultural building and it was subsequently decided it did not require prior approval permission on the 4th May 2017 The Parish Council had objected, as it firmly believes, this site should be subject to proper planning and believed this second application was to simply reduce the size in order to comply with terms of part Q of the GDPOs.

Clearly our concerns were well founded, however we now believe that under planning regulations that this application requires it to be viewed as a whole and that it should be refused, as the shed while not requiring approval under PA/2017/483, which allowed its reduction in size. It is clear from PA/2016/2026, the overall size and subsequent partial demolition, it is still one development and therefore does not qualify for permission under the GDPOs and therefore should be subject to a full planning application as it is a rural building in the open countryside.

The following applications received from NLC were discussed by the Parish Council.

2017/1098 – planning permission to erect a replacement dwelling and demolition of existing barn and associated outbuildings at Willows Farm, East Lound Road, Haxey (amended site address). **Resolved** – Object with the following comments: -

A certificate of lawfulness was granted to this property, it is to the rear of other properties had it been subject to a planning application, our observation would have been it was back land development. The barn appears to be within the building envelope, however the development does encroach on the open countryside. While one of the given reasons for the development is to accommodate an elderly relative it is over development of the site, substantially higher than the building to which a certificate of lawfulness was granted and is wholly different to a barn, it will have an overall impact on the amenity of the other properties in the location.

We are mindful of this and feel any grant of planning by NLC should have a condition that recognises no further development should be attached to it on the basis of a precedent in order to protect this area from any further back land development.

The bungalow on the site is currently used to run a business from and the ménage to the rear of the property is used for lessons. There are discrepancies on the application form as the property is not solely domestic, there are trees on the site but not on the plan and the roof could contain asbestos.

Proposed: Cllr Carlile, seconded: Cllr Condliff. 9 for with 2 abstentions.

2017/1441 – planning permission to erect a detached house and detached garage at 28 Doncaster Road, Westwoodside.

Resolved – no objection or comments.

Proposed: Cllr Foreman, seconded: Cllr Whitehead. 8 for, 1 against with 2 abstentions.

2017/1444 – planning permission to erect a single storey rear extension at Coneygarth Farm, 12 Turbary Road, Haxey.

Resolved – no objection or comment.

Proposed: Cllr Orton, seconded: Cllr Booth. 10 for with 1 abstention.

2017/1469 – planning permission to convert existing garage and store room into hot food take away (A5) and carry out associated external alterations at 17 Low Street, Haxey.

Clerk read out a letter of objection received from a resident of Low Road and it was noted there were a large number of objections on the NLC planning portal.

Resolved – object with the following comments: -

While mainly a residential area there is a small number of retail units in the area, parking facilities are already a problem and this application, should it succeed, will create further problems. We are concerned by the likely impact of smell to neighbouring residential properties and question the sustainability of such an outlet given the amount of fast food outlets available in nearby towns and villages. Whilst, the Parish Council welcome new local business development, this is fundamentally not the right location.

Proposed: Cllr Booth, seconded: Cllr Lange. 10 for with 1 abstention.

2017/1493 – outline planning permission to erect a single storey detached dwelling and garage with all matters reserved for subsequent approval at Caravan, The Meadows, Carr Lane, East Lound. The Clerk read out a letter from East Lound residents. Cllr Condliff wanted it noting that she was not aware of the letter prior to the meeting.

Resolved – strongly object with the following comments: -

It is accepted that the applicant has now recently established a right to live at this site by gaining a certificate of lawfulness to site a static residential caravan. This was agreed by the Parish Council over the preceding months with the Authority and the agreement was for a single caravan to be sited at this location for the purpose of residency. The question now is do we agree with the new proposal, as it will require in affect 2 units. There is some argument that it will be an improvement to the area, however given the types of property in the proximity of the site, it falls far short of improving the overall street scene. It also seeks to establish outline planning for a dwelling which is in the open countryside, we object most strongly to this part of the application as clearly it would not normally be granted under the NLC local plan.

Any approval granted should have a condition that all other residential caravans are to be removed. The Parish Council is particularly concerned about this application which, following the recommendation by the Planning Authority to accede to the retention of one caravan, which would be the only occupation on the site, now appears to be turning into a major development project. The Parish Council has been lobbied by local Residents over this application, particularly over the potential erection of a house and garage; moreover, anecdotally, local Residents have endured numerous disturbances at the site involving the Police. The Residents observe that there is considerable confusion over the application and whether there will ultimately be a building or a

caravan at the site and the application design statement makes promises based on a successful application, which in planning terms cannot be formally adhered to. Finally, the Residents confirm that the site is outside the Village boundary and should therefore not be granted building consent.

Proposed: Cllr Booth, seconded: Cllr Carlile. 10 for with 1 abstention.

2017/1506 – planning permission to retain garden shed at 40 High Street, Haxey.

Resolved – no objection or comment.

Proposed: Cllr Condliff, seconded: Cllr Booth. 10 for with 1 abstention.

2017/1535 – planning permission to erect a first-floor extension to main dwelling and erect a glass link from existing house to barn to create annex with the erection of rear balcony at South View, Church Lane, Haxey.

Resolved – no objection or comment.

Proposed: Cllr Orton, seconded: Cllr Smedley. 8 for, 1 against with 2 abstentions.

2017/1546 – planning permission to erect a detached dwelling at 30 Doncaster Road, Westwoodside.

Resolved – no objection or comment.

Proposed: Cllr Orton, seconded: Cllr Smedley. 9 for with 2 abstentions.

2017/1594 – planning permission to erect a conservatory at 12 Eastmoor Villas, Epworth Road, Haxey.

Resolved – no objection or comment.

Proposed: Cllr Foreman, seconded: Cllr Lange. 10 for with 1 abstention.

2017/1612 – planning permission to replace 6 no sectional concrete battery garages and erect 6 no sectional concrete garages on the same footprint at garages off Blackmoor Road, Haxey.

Resolved – no objection, comment that aesthetically the build would look better in brick and the Parish Council would recommend that this suggestion is taken up.

Proposed: Cllr Foreman, seconded: Cllr Lange. 10 for with 1 abstention.

2017/1640 – planning permission to retain the siting of a beacon with parish shield at land adjacent to Telecommunications Mast 1, Haxey Water Tower, Tower Hill, Westwoodside.

Cllr Knowles updated the Council stating that NLC Highway had been consulted prior to a planning application being submitted who had agreed the location was ok but the shield needed moving to the opposite side so as not to impede on any maintenance of the verge.

Resolved – no objection or comment.

Proposed: Cllr Booth, seconded: Cllr Condliff. 7 for, 1 against with 3 abstentions.

Cllr Foreman suggested that a plaque is erected to indicate that the beacon had been donated and by whom. Cllr Foreman to confirm with Mr Jones that he would be happy for this to be erected. Item for the next agenda.

b. To receive an update on planning issues.

Clampit Creek/Walkabout Farm – no further update.

Haxey Carr Study Centre – NLC are waiting for a response from the land owner and will chase this in due course.

Haxey Carr Barn – NLC have advised the owner to remove the steel work from site, to date this has not been done so therefore the NLC legal team will now act.

Caravan – **East Lound** – details above. A site visit has taken place with NLC and the Police attending to determine how many caravans are on the site to allow the drafting of an enforcement notice for any unauthorised development.

Shed - Tindale Bank – NLC have visited the site several times and have left cards for the owner to contact NLC and it is thought no one lives on the site; however, lights have recently been observed there recently. NLC will keep attempting to make contact with the owner.

Children's Home – Low Burnham – appeal has been dismissed, Ward Cllrs and the Leader of NLC will meet with Planning and Legal to discuss the way forward. The Parish Council acknowledges the fact that the appeal has been dismissed even though some of the issues raised by the Parish Council, in our opinion, have not been given the appropriate weighting. **Haxey** – planning permission has been refused and this is now subject to appeal.

Garage – Low Burnham – appeal has been submitted.

Croft Bank Farm, Langholme Lane – a reminder letter has been sent to the owner as the play equipment is still on the site. An enforcement notice will be drafted in due course.

Static caravan – Langholme Lane – ongoing.

1710/07 Clerks Report

- a. A meeting was held on 11/10 at Westwoodside Primary School with Cllrs Knowles, Carlile, Booth and Allcock and Rose attending to discuss the recent results of a survey carried out by the school. The survey is to try and get pupils to walk to school and a few issues were raised.
 - Faded road lining outside the school Cllr Allcock stated these had now been redone. Cllr Allcock also stated he is pursing possible measures to slow traffic from Tower Hill approaching the junction with Nethergate.
 - Dog fouling.
 - Narrow footpaths.

Cllr Allcock took all the issues back to NLC.

The Head teacher stated she had introduced a scheme to encourage the children to walk to school and they were getting involved in designing 'no dog fouling' posters.

53 children are to attend the Remembrance Service this year.

- e. The Clerk has booked the ERNLLCA Conference for Cllrs Booth, Condliff, Lindley & Knowles and provided each with information on what seminars they would be attending.

Improvement / Projects

1710/08 To receive an update on the Isle of Axholme Hatfield Chase projects determining if any further actions are required.

There has been a couple of meetings to progress the digitisation of the parish documentation to allow upload on to the website – funding to be sought to carry out the specifics required.

The Clerk is working on a grant for the cleaning of the memorials in the parish.

The mounting stone has been repaired.

1710/09 To receive an update/report with regard to the Parish Beacon determining any further actions required.

The planning application is awaiting approval from NLC.

Highways / Neighbourhood Services / North Lincolnshire Council items

1710/10 To determine any further actions with regard to the Westwoodside Business Action Group and the highway issues.

An article was placed into the Arrow asking for residents to come forward with any available land to locate parking. The issue will be progressed when residents come forward.

1710/11 To be notified of the NLC draft proposal with regard to parking restrictions on the Nooking and the recent school meeting determining actions required.

Work has commenced and will take approximately a further 4 weeks to complete. A letter has been submitted to staff, parents and residents from the Headteacher stating that there will be no parking restrictions for 3 months to see if the lay-by is being used in a considerate and sensible manner, if not, restrictions will be introduced.

1710/12 To determine actions required with regard to the state of the Kings Arms including the possible submission of an asset of community value determining actions required.

The Clerk contacted the agent who has stated that there is an interested party. Clerk to see when and if this will be completed and if not in the near future clerk will contact NLC about the state of the grassed land including the use of the car park by a nearby business.

- 1710/13 To consider placing a weight restriction on Idle Bank Road determining any actions required. Cllr Carlile stated that this is raised at NATs meetings regularly and after taking into consideration access required by local farmers and residents a weight restriction should be considered on the 200m of highway that at present does not service anyone. HGVs then using the road to take a short cut will have to find alternative routes. Cllr Allcock also stated he had raised this with NLC on numerous occasions and will take back again for investigating.

 A work ticket has been raised as previously stated and the work will be scheduled in when possible.

 Cllr Allcock stated that various roads and footpaths have been resurfaced/redressed in the parish recently.

Cllr Allcock has attended the Snow Sewer demaining Drop-In meeting and will complete the relevant consultation on behalf of the Parish Council. The Parish Council agreed to support the proposal for the IDB to take on the maintenance from the EA as long as there is a commuted sum of money on takeover and some maintenance money in the first few years.

1710/16 To receive a report from the Westwoodside Playing Field Management Committee.

A meeting was held earlier in the month. A resident has complained about the tarmacking of the lane and therefore a meeting is being held at the Centre 01/11 to discuss with NLC.

A new CCTV system has been fitted which will provide remote access.

1710/17 To receive a report for Haxey Playing Field Association.

Cllr Lange had provided the Clerk with an update prior to the meeting which she read out.

- The PFA have a quiz night on 11th November.
- The PFA have acquired a second-hand kitchen (like new) and are paying to have it fitted in both the tennis/football pavilion in time for the start of the tennis season.
- Some trees are to be trimmed overhanging the cricket pitch, together with some which are close to some adjacent houses.
- A race night is also being organised for later in the year.
- 1710/18 To receive an update report on hydro-carbon activities in the area and to be notified of the correspondence from IGAS with regard to their Community Fund 2018 determining actions required. No report received from Cllr Fiddler.

1710/19 To receive an update report from the Planting Working Group including the North Lincolnshire in Bloom project determining further actions required.

Some winter pansies have been purchased and a further batch ordered.

Cllrs Booth, Lindley & Smedley have been looking at planters for the parish to be purchased with the North Lincolnshire in Bloom project funds and their recommendations will be presented at the next meeting. It was agreed to send a thank you to NLC for the funding.

1710/20 To receive an update report from the ERNLLCA District Committee Meeting and the NLC Town & Parish Council liaison meeting determining any actions required.

Cllr Knowles attended and stated that there had been a good turn out to the ERNLLCA District Meeting.

Several items had been on the agendas including Council Committees, ERNLLCA Password control on to the website, Satellite broadband and the recent reduction of Town Councillors. Presentations had been circulated from the Liaison Meeting.
