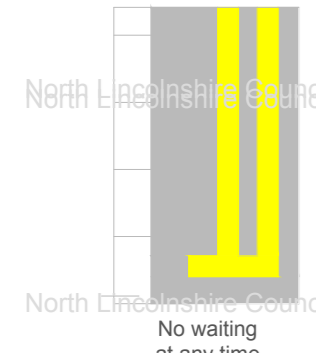


ENFORCEABLE RESTRICTIONS UNDER CONSIDERATION FOR NEWBIGG - WESTWOODSIDE

- WAITING RESTRICTIONS**
- Double yellow lines mean no waiting at any time.
 - Waiting restrictions indicated by yellow lines apply to the carriageway, pavement and verge.
 - You may stop to load or unload (unless there are loading restrictions) or when dropping off or picking up passengers.
 - If no days are shown on the signs, the restrictions are in force every day including Sundays and Bank Holidays. Where days are shown the restrictions apply on those days, including school and bank holidays.
