Heritage Event

The Parish Council was invited to attend the Heritage Event organised by the Haxey and Westwoodside Heritage Society on 11th May, and was able to put on display for the public the Awards of the Commissioners book dated 1803, and the Tithe Book, dated 1847. These original documents contain maps and information about the enclosures and about who owned and rented individual parcels of land in the Parish at that time. Many visitors found these to be of considerable historic interest and asked if they could be seen again.

There were also numerous displays of historical artefacts & photographs, provided by various local groups & organisations and the Memorial Hall was full of visitors during the afternoon. The majority of the photographs, came from the collection of Mrs Norma Neill, there are still many more, as yet unseen by the public, so it is hoped that a further event can be arranged by members of the Heritage Society in the near future.
